The " Inskip Card File" is the most comprehensive record of Rolls Royce cars which, to my knowledge, still exists, and it is fortunate that this is now in the possession of the club.

The only information which I have is contained in a set of Branch Territorial Lists which were kept in my office while RRofAm., Inc. was still in existence. These were prepared by the Branches and were arranged alphabetically to list the name and address of each of their Customers, and to show the chassis no. of each of their cars. Some of these showed the basic type of body, but none listed the body no. The original lists were changed to agree with new sales and changes in ownership only until about mid 1930 when curtailment of staff necessitated elimination of non essential details. Information on the later series of P1 cars is, therefore incomplete, and I am unable to supply anything on the PRs, LRs and most of the KRs on your list.
